Synergy benefits systems, and all systems are design compromises.

The goal of: "complete elimination of victimization" in one dimension creates other parasitic adversities and/or victimizations which sum to a net loss of system functionality.

The inputs of single-issue group, particularly "anti-____" groups, should be evaluated in this context.

Consider cats: Not all muscle, or bones, or skin, or brains, because that wouldn't be synergistic. In most cases, cats control rodent populations rather than make them extinct. Extinctions are risky. Control the worst rodents first, because "leadership sets the tone".

Perhaps the people who refuse to make their exercised desires "not a curse" to other people can be peacefully marginalized. There's a challenge.
